1.1	To seek committee approval to amend one of the six sites being considered under the Community Management of Assets pilot.
2.0	Recommendations
2.1	The Members of the Committee are asked to agree that Willowbank Park is removed from the pilot and replaced by Lenadoon Park.
3.0	Main report
3.1	Key Issues Council appointed consultants to pilot an approach to Community Management of Assets at six agreed sites.

3.2	At the People and Communities committee on 11 October 2022 a Councillor asked officers to consider removing the Willowbank site and replacing it with Lenadoon, subject to the local groups confirming their willingness.
3.3	Officers have had confirmation that the local groups are content with this arrangement and now ask committee to record approval of this decision which may lead to long term external management of the council asset at Lenadoon Park.
