## Re: Lower Ormeau Residents Action Group (LORAG)

I refer to our telephone conversation last week regarding the project at Shaftesbury Recreation Centre and Sport Northern Ireland's funding offer.

The project has been approved for funding because of the community nature of the project, and the programmes the applicant will be implementing. The value of our award indicates the far reaching benefits this project will have and is a measure of the detail of the sports development plan, which relies on a large number of partner organisations to deliver it.
