3.1		e Committee will be aware that Standing Orders 13 (m) to (r), as agreed by the Council at meeting on 4th October, are as follows:			
	(m)	The Standards and Business Committee will have delegated authority to adopt or reject Notices of Motion. The Lord Mayor will indicate at the Council meeting those Notices of Motion that have been considered by the Standards and Business Committee and whether such Notices of Motion were rejected or adopted. In either case, the proposer only may speak on the issue at Council.			
	(n)	The Standards and Business Committee will refer all Notices of Motion directly to a standing committee when the matter to which the Notice of Motion refers falls within the remit of that committee. At Council, the Lord Mayor will indicate that the Notice of Motion was received and referred. There will be no speakers on such Notices of Motion at Council.			
	(0)	The Standards and Business Committee will refer Notices of Motion for consideration by full Council when the Notice of Motion relates to a strategic or constitutional matter.			
	(p)	The Standards and Business Committee will not have the power to amend the wording of any Notice of Motion that is being referred to the full Council for debate.			
	(q)	Any amendments to Notice of Motions to be proposed at the Council are to be furnished at least one day in advance of going to the full Council and will be circulated to Party Group Leaders in advance of the Council meeting.			
	(r)	In referring any matter to the full Council, the Standards and Business Committee may determine to restrict contributions to the debate in relation to any Notice of Motion to one per political party. At the Council meeting, the Lord Mayor will clearly indicate if the restriction applies.

	"This C	Council notes with horror Israels' ongoing war crimes in Gaza.			
	them c	ling to UN statistics, over 28,000 Palestinians have now been killed, 10,000 of hildren. 60,000 people have been injured, with 1.9 million more displaced, with infrastructure decimated under Israeli bombs.			

Despite repeated calls from international human rights organisations for a ceasefire, Israel continues to bombard and assault an already beleaquered population in Gaza.

The Council recognises Israel's actions are facilitated by the military, financial and political support of Western Governments, most notably Joe Biden and the US Administration: which gives \$3.8billion of US military aid each year to Israel.

Further notes the US administration has been a consistent supporter of the zionist project historically, and an enthusiastic proponent of Israel's current offensive which has caused such death and destruction in Gaza.

In recent months, the US has used its power on the UN security Council to block calls for a humanitarian ceasefire, vetoed UN efforts to send aid to Gaza, and allocated emergency military funding to Israel in 2023. The current Biden administration has even taken the unprecedented move of bypassing Congress in order to transfer more arms to Israel to support its ongoing genocide in Gaza.

In this context, this years St Patrick's Day presents an opportunity for Irish politicians to promote the principles of Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions: by refusing to meet or engage with any US officials complicit in Israeli war crimes.

By boycotting these ceremonies we could send a resounding message to the people of Gaza, and the world, that Ireland stands with Palestine.

The Council will therefore write to the Irish Taoiseach and all political parties North and South in Ireland calling on them not to attend St Patrick's Day celebrations in the White House, nor to meet with President Joe Biden or any representative of his administration as part of the St Patrick's Day events.

The Council will also write to Claire Cronin, US Ambassador to Ireland, British Foreign Secretary, David Cameron and Josep Borrell, High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, calling for an immediate suspension of all military, financial, and diplomatic support for apartheid Israel and its genocidal war on Palestine."

3.3 The motion calls upon the Council to undertake a number of actions, that is, calling on all political parties North and South in Ireland to not attend St. Patrick's Day celebrations in The White House and to write further letters for an immediate suspension of all military, financial, and diplomatic support for apartheid Israel and its genocidal war on Palestine - the Committee can either adopt the motion, refer it for debate at the Council meeting (with or without restrictions) or reject the motion.
