I am writing to bring you up to date with the first-ever event bringing together Belfast and America at the Alamo in order to request some support from the Development Department for this initiative which could have very positive lasting impacts for our tourism and investment efforts.

The Harp and Shamrock Society is the oldest Irish American society in San Antonio. Each St Patrick's Day at High Noon, they organise a special commemoration at the Alamo for the Scots-Irish, Irish and Irish Americans who died at the Alamo.

The Irish Echo, sister paper of the Belfast Media Group titles and the oldest and biggest-selling newspaper serving Irish America (www.irishecho.com), is joining forces with them to organise the inaugural Texas Irish American Leaders Awards dinner on 4 June in the Menger Hotel (San Antonio's oldest hotel, directly opposite the Alamo). We have considerable experience in organising positive promotional events as you can see at www.events.belfastmedia.com.

It's our intention to make this San Antonio celebration an annual event which gives us the potential to forge fresh links between Belfast and the city of the Alamo. This would complement Council activity in Nashville and Austin. After meeting the Ulster-Scots Agency ceo today, I'm hopeful they will also get involved in this link-up.

We have an opportunity to form a partnership with San Antonio, springboarded from this event, which has tourism potential for Belfast but which also gives us an opportunity to learn from San Antonio's (San Antonio is the seventh largest city in US) exemplary regeneration and link to its strong economy. I have contacted the Belfast Visitor and Convention Bureau to inform them that I would be willing to display their Belfast exhibition at the event.

Some ways the Council could support this bridgebuilding effort include with a modest outlay:

A Letter of greetings and gift from the Council's Development Department to be accepted by the representative of the city of San Antonio at the event.

Sponsoring an Award at the Dinner for someone who has made a contribution to Texas-

Belfast linkages. (Interestingly, one of our sponsors, David Millar of Haisley Millar Consulting Group of Houston previously served on a council business forum.) Showcasing Belfast's proposition in the Texas supplement which The Irish Echo will publish for this event.

Encouraging Tourism Ireland to row in behind the event to ensure its success and to ensure Belfast is adequately marketed at the event and in subsequent activities.

I understand that Council Development Department repesentatives will be in Austin in March and I would be willing to use our good offices to facilitate with local business and Irish American/Scots-Irish groups a visit to city officials and to the Alamo.

I trust you will raise this through the appropriate channels.
