Summer Scheme 2010

Criteria

- 1 The submission of a wide ranging and varied programme of activities appropriate to the ages and stages of development of the children and young people involved.
- 2. Information submitted by the group detailing premises, timescale, minimum number of weeks and sessions, activities and the ratio of volunteers to children and young people involved in the scheme.
- **3.** Agreement to comply with the review and monitoring procedures.

In applying for Summer Scheme funding groups must demonstrate:-

- **1.** A high level of organised, local community involvement.
- **2.** The ability to properly account for funding.
- **3.** Recent experience within the group of planning and organising a play schemes for children and young people.
- **4.** That the group is providing a play scheme which is meeting the needs and responding to a demand that is not adequately addressed by the other groups in the same area or neighbourhood.
- **5.** A Child Protection Policy and Procedures.
