

Summer Scheme 2010

Criteria

- 1 The submission of a wide ranging and varied programme of activities appropriate to the ages and stages of development of the children and young people involved.
2. Information submitted by the group detailing premises, timescale, minimum number of weeks and sessions, activities and the ratio of volunteers to children and young people involved in the scheme.
3. Agreement to comply with the review and monitoring procedures.

In applying for Summer Scheme funding groups must demonstrate:-

1. A high level of organised, local community involvement.
2. The ability to properly account for funding.
3. Recent experience within the group of planning and organising a play schemes for children and young people.
4. That the group is providing a play scheme which is meeting the needs and responding to a demand that is not adequately addressed by the other groups in the same area or neighbourhood.
5. A Child Protection Policy and Procedures.

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
