## **Relevant Background Information**

St George's City Food and Garden Market has been short listed for the BBC Food & Farming Award 2010 in 'Best Food Category' (appendix 1). This award is highly thought of in the Food Markets Industry.

### Key Issues

BBC Radio 4 launched the BBC Food & Farming Awards in St James's Palace in 2000. St George's City Food & Garden Market has been short listed in the 'Best Food Market' category 2010. This is a national UK award and highly thought of in the Market industry. The other short-listed markets are Stoke Newington Farmers' Market and Stroud Farmers' Market.

The award ceremony is being held in the NEC Birmingham on Wednesday 24 November 2010 and two representatives from Belfast City Council Markets Unit have been invited to attend.

## **Resource Implications**

Finance:

The cost of travel and one night's accommodation in Birmingham for two people, including subsistence would not exceed  $\pounds 600$ . This money would be available through the markets budget.
