## Cow-munity

Manchester is made up of many different communities and has a wealth of creative talent. The City is experiencing a period of renaissance through extensive regeneration and the Arts have played an essential part in regeneration programmes throughout the City.

Manchester City Council wanted to engage with residents living across the City's regeneration areas, to involve them in CowParade Manchester, and to showcase their work to a larger audience. To do this, a new scheme – Cow-munity – was created.

Cow-munity has enabled local groups to develop individual projects working with professional artists to create their own cow in their own neighbourhood. Cow-munity has succeeded in engaging local residents in a citywide project to make Manchester's CowParade unique. The scheme gives a whole range of people the chance to explore their creativity and show off the talent and ingenuity we have throughout our communities.

Projects include: a cow made from recycling products, created with Newall Green High School in Wythenshawe; six year old pupils in Crumpsall imagining their favourite places; an aerosol art project developing skills for young people outside the formal school system in East Manchester; and open day workshops to tile the Victoria Baths cow.

A selection of images from the Cow-munity Scheme will be displayed in the Light Boxes at Piccadilly Station. Sponsored by GMPT with support from Arts & Business NW New Partners investment programme.

The Cow-munity Scheme has been developed by Manchester City Council Events Unit and Cultural Strategy Team, who wish to thank the funders - Neighbourhood Renewal Fund, Arts Council England, Northwest and Arts & Business NW, together with the many partners for their very generous support.

## Cow Facts

Cows can identify a smell up to five miles away.

Cows may refuse to graze if they sense an impending storm, and will lie down. Scientists attribute this behaviour to the lowering pressure preceding a storm.

It takes 340 squirts to fill a milk pail. A cow gives nearly 200,000 glasses of milk in her lifetime.

A cow eats about 100 pounds of grass and produces about 65 pounds of manure each day.

Cows can live up to 30 years.

Cows will walk up stairs but never down stairs.

A cow's spots are as unique as a human's fingerprints.

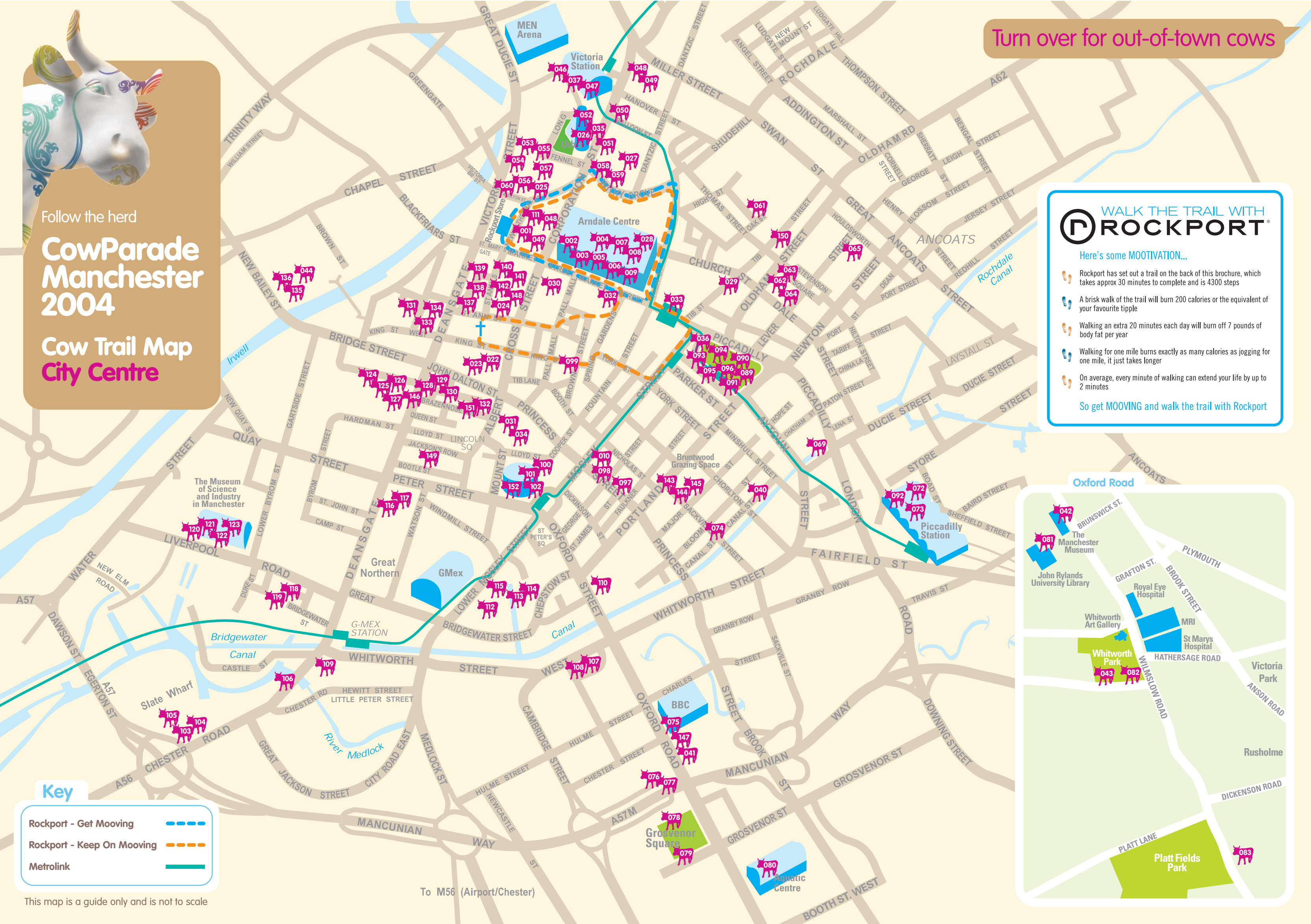
