1	Relevant Background Information
1.1	The purpose of this report is to consider the annual review of prices for hire/rental charges at the Belfast Waterfront, Ulster Hall, St George's Market and Community Centres and to agree an implementation with effect from 1 April 2012.

2	Key Issues
2.1	Belfast Waterfront / Ulster Hall In 2011/2012, it was decided that there would be no price increase and it is recommended that the existing prices are retained in 2012/2013, for hire charges relating to all areas of the Belfast Waterfront, including Main Auditorium, Studio, Meeting Rooms, Exhibition areas including Concourse, Gallery Levels 1 and 2, Bar Levels 1 and 2 and also the Ulster Hall and, where appropriate, event services hire charges.
	It is suggested that the proposed "no price increase" for 2012/2013 is necessary to keep hire fees at both venues competitive in what will inevitably be a very difficult trading environment over the next 12 months.
2.2	St Georges Market
	In January 2010 Members approved an increase in stallage and hire charges for a 2 year period from 1 st April 2010. It is recommended that members do not apply a price increase in 2012/2013 due to the ongoing difficult economic trading conditions.
2.3	<u>Community Centres</u> Prices have remained the same from 2010/2011- it is recommended that this continues and no price increase is applied in 2012/2013.

3	Resource Implications
3.1	<u>Financial</u> The recommendations above have all been factored into the Departmental Revenue Estimates for 2012/2013 approved by Committee in January 2012.
3.2	Human Resources
	There are no additional human resource requirements in relation to implementation of the proposed Pricing Policy.

4	Equality and Good Relations Considerations
	There are no equality implications in agreeing the 2012/2013 Departmental Scale of Charges.

5	Recommendations
