	<p>The Committee will recall that the Shadow Council, at its meeting on 9th February, passed the following motion, which had been moved by Councillor Carson and seconded by Councillor Hutchinson:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“Belfast District Council agrees to establish a pilot programme to extend the super-connected scheme to include domestic-use properties, so as to address issues associated with pensioner poverty.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">The Council, during this pilot programme, will engage with our community, statutory and corporate partners to maximise the potential advantages of the extension of the super-connected scheme and thereby reduce social isolation and improve the economic situation of our most vulnerable older people across the City.”</p> <p>In accordance with Standing Order 16.1 of the Local Government (Standing Orders) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014, the Presiding Councillor confirmed that the matter would be referred without discussion to the Shadow Strategic Policy and Resources Committee for consideration.</p>
