Bank Square Project – Introduction of raised platforms

As part of the Belfast: Streets Ahead Programme, the Department for Social Development (DSD) is taking forward the Bank Square Regeneration Project. This scheme is also the first major project to flow from the Westside Regeneration Masterplan and focuses on Bank Square, Bank Street, Berry Street, Chapel Lane and King Street South (from Castle Street to College Square).


It is intended that the capital works stage will commence in the spring of 2013 and last for 18 months.

As part of the construction works it is proposed to introduce two raised platforms, on Berry Street West at the junction with Chapel Lane and the second at the junction of King Street and College Avenue. The attached drawings show details of the proposal.

Also proposed is the introduction of the use of a rise and fall bollard on Chapel Lane 13 metres from Berry Street (entrance system).
