ENTERTAINMENTS LICENCE

Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (N.I.) Order 1985 Article 3, Schedule 1 – Licensing of Places of Entertainment

The Council of the City of Belfast, in pursuance of the provisions of Article 3 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1985, hereby grants

hereinafter referred to as the Licensee, for the use of the place

and situated at Falls Road, Belfast,

from 1st September 2011 until 31st August 2012 inclusive,

in the said City for the purpose of the entertainments listed in the Schedule hereunder and subject to any restrictions or special conditions as may be also listed hereunder, unless the same shall have been previously transferred, cancelled, varied, suspended or revoked; provided that the Licence is granted on the terms and conditions and subject to the restrictions as are specified in the Conditions thereof and shall be liable to be revoked if the Licensee is convicted of an offence in respect of the Place being used for any entertainment otherwise than in accordance with the terms, conditions or restrictions on or subject to which the Licence is held and shall be liable to be suspended if it appears to the Council that the provision of any entertainment at the Place is causing or is likely to cause a serious threat to public order or public safety.

- 1. 7 days prior to any particular event the licensee may apply for additional hours. These may be granted dependent upon any previous noise issues which have arisen.
- 2. Maximum numbers will be agreed at the discretion of the Service and will vary depending upon individual concert set up proposals.

OUTDOOR CONDITIONS

- 28 days prior to any proposed event the following shall be provided to the satisfaction of Building Control Service:
 - Exact dates, proposed start and finish times and nature of the entertainment to be provided
 - An Event Management and Safety Plan including any relevant risk assessments
 - Layout plan (Scale 1:100) indicating the position of exits/entrances, seating, stage, toilet facilities, escape routes and any other features associated with the event.
 - A suitable noise assessment and noise management plan, which should also include the position and
 orientation of the stage and loudspeakers and details of proposals to ensure adequate neighbourhood
 consultation, is undertaken. The noise assessment must be completed by a suitably qualified and
 experienced noise control consultant and demonstrate that noise from the event will not cause
 unreasonable disturbance to commercial and residential premises in the vicinity.
- 2. Maximum numbers will be agreed at the discretion of the Service and will vary depending upon individual concert set up proposals.
- **3.** If a stage is being used the following certification will be required confirming:
 - The design of the stage structure,
 - The stage has been erected in accordance with the manufacturers instructions,
 - The electrical installation is maintained and will prevent danger arising there from,
 - All fire extinguishers are properly maintained,
 - A sufficient and suitable range of fire extinguishers shall be provided. In particular, Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) fire extinguishers and a fire blanket shall be provided on any stage area.
- **4.** A valid policy of insurance shall be held by the licensee throughout the period of the event insuring in respect of any liability, which may be incurred by him in respect of the death of or bodily injury to any person while in or about the marguee and site.
 - Scaffolding, metal frameworks, bars and beams on which electrical equipment is fixed should be sufficiently earthed. If earthing connections are looped, care must be taken that the conductor size is adequate throughout its length. Metalwork and portable electrical equipment shall be protected by residual current devices having a nominal tripping current of 30MA,
- 5. The licensee or a nominated responsible person shall, during the whole time that the place is open to the public, be readily identifiable at all times and shall be assisted by sufficient staff of competent adult attendants who will have been specifically instructed as to their duties, the main aim of which is the orderly evacuation of the place and the avoidance of panic in the event of an emergency. This shall include the method of calling the Fire and Rescue Service and the fastest means of evacuating the place in a safe and orderly matter.
- **6.** Where necessary, adequate sanitary accommodation shall be provided to the satisfaction of the Service and at least one sanitary appliance shall be accessible to, and designed for use by, disabled persons. Sanitary accommodation and washing facilities shall be maintained in good Working order, kept clean, ventilated, disinfected and supplied with all proper requisites.
- 7. Facilities for access to and within the place for disabled people shall also be provided.
- **8.** Suitable storage shall be made available for the accumulation of refuse, waste paper, etc. pending its removal from the place. Combustible waste shall be placed in metal containers pending refuse collection.
- **9.** The Service may also introduce, modify or dispense with such conditions as it thinks appropriate for the event and type of entertainment.
