3.1	<u>Key Issues</u> The power for the Council to name streets is contained in Article 11 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (NI) Order 1995.									
3.2	Members are asked to consider the following applications for naming new streets in the City. The application particulars are in order and the Royal Mail has no objections to the proposed names. The proposed new names are not contained in the Council's Streets Register and do not duplicate existing approved street names in the City.

<p>3.4</p> <p>3.5</p> <p>3.6</p> <p>3.7</p> <p>3.8</p>	<p>Apex Housing Association has advised that they consulted the principal of a school adjacent to the site and Corrigan Heights was put forward as the new street name as the site is located in an area close to Corrigan Park which is a GAA ground on the Whiterock Road and is connected to the local history of the area.</p> <p>Fold Housing Association have submitted a first preference of Global Crescent as the name for this new social housing site located at Millar Street between the Ravenhill and Woodstock Roads. It has been designated as a Shared Neighbourhood development under the OFMDFM’s “Together Building A United Community Strategy”. In keeping with the ethos of the shared neighbourhood initiative, Fold approached local schools in the area and asked them to propose names for the new development. The teachers and children were briefed on the shared neighbourhood context of the project and their first preference for the street name is Global Crescent whilst the second preference is Respect Crescent.</p> <p>In the event that neither of the two proposed names is recommended by Committee, Fold has proposed Pearldye Mews as a third choice. This name was proposed because the site was formerly known as the Devonshire Laundry. This was one of a number of laundries owned by the Pearl Dye Works Ltd. As the name Devonshire exists in West Belfast, Fold have proposed to name the street after the company who owned the laundry.</p> <p><u>Financial &amp; Resource Implications</u> There are no Financial, Human Resources, Assets and other implications in this report.</p> <p><u>Equality or Good Relations Implications</u> There are no direct Equality implications.</p>
