#### 1 Relevant Background Information

Andersonstown Leisure Centre have received a request for use of facilities from HCD Promotions LLP. HCD promotions have outlined that they are to run a Celtic Festival event with the intention to hold 2 of the 5 day events in Andersonstown Leisure Centre. This would involve a number of Celtic players and celebrities such as John Higgins (world snooker champion), Kevin Bridges (comedian) and George Galloway MP attending the events.

A financial donation from HCD promotions LLP will also be made to the West Belfast Suicide Awareness Support Group. This is a ticket only event and tickets will be sold through 'Ticket master'.

## 2 Key Issues

An application for the use of the Main Hall (event time 7pm -1am) and surrounding rooms at Andersonstown Leisure Centre on Friday 4 March and Saturday 5 March 2011 inclusive of set up, site clearance and clean up on Sunday 6 March 2011 has been received from the HCD Promotions LLP.

The facility request is for a traditional music evening with Charlie & the Bhoys group playing music on Friday 4 March 2011 and singer Patricia Ferns on Saturday 5 March 2011.

Bar facilities would be required on both nights.

The organiser has undertaken to provide the following information in support of the application:

- A formal letter of application (attached at Appendix I)
- Safety statement (draft submitted)
- Risk Assessments
- Public Liability Insurance (being handled by Hutchinson, White & Co).
- Occasional licence (applied for)
- List of security staff and registration numbers

# 3 Resource Implications

#### Financial

The fee charged to HCD Promotions LLP will be in line with Council charging policy and will include staff costs for out of opening hours use.

# Asset and Other implications

Council officers will liaise with organisers in relation to the potential environmental impact of this event.

- All legislative and operational requirements being met to the satisfaction of the Council;
- The decision of the Licensing Committee regarding the entertainment licence for the event;
- Bar facilities being operated within the terms of the occasional licence once received.
