1	Relevant Background Information
	The Committee is reminded that at its meeting in September 2011 it asked that a monthly progress report be submitted to Committee on the refurbishment of the Mary Peters Track.

2	Key Issues
	The current position is as follows:
	<ol> <li>The tender process is nearing completion and the scheme remains on target to be on site by the end of March 2012;</li> </ol>
	2. Trees have now been removed in accordance with the previously agreed management plan. The removal has been necessary in advance of the works to avoid the nesting season. A programme of tree replanting on the site and across a range of other sites is part of the overall scheme.
	<ol> <li>Discussions with the Planning Service have indicated that there are no significant issues and approval is expected shortly.</li> </ol>

	<u>Financial</u> There are no additional financial implications.
	Human Resources There are no additional human resource implications; work is being progressed within existing resources.

<u>Asset and Other Implications</u> The refurbishment of the track will safeguard the future of facility and provide improved facilities for users of the track and spectators.
