1. Relevant Background Information

The Committee will be aware that as part of the ongoing discussions ahead of the implementation of Local Government Reform Council Officers have been meeting with their counterparts in Belfast Regeneration Office to share information and identify potential common interest projects with a view to increased shared working in the run up to April 2015.

At a recent meeting there was some discussion around a proposal received by BRO seeking capital funding in relation to the Midland Boxing Club. During the discussions Council Officers were asked to work with BRO to move this project forward and agree to commission and oversee the development of an economic appraisal. The request was premised on:

- 1. The Council's recently published Boxing Strategy; and
- 2. That site on which the existing facility is built is currently leased from the Council.

The key issue for the Committee to authorise Council Officers to commission the undertaking of a Economic Appraisal to determine the feasibility of a purpose built building to accommodate the needs of the Midland ABC.
