

- provide high-speed internet access;
- be located on the same floor or wing of the hotel to avoid mixing with other teams or hotel guests;
- existing hotel infrastructure must make it easy to secure the premises;
- flexible food arrangements, allowing the national team's chefs to use the hotel's kitchen and to bring their own food;
- one suitable dining area to accommodate all teams;
- player's lounge (recreational area equipped with table tennis, pool table, table football, computer with Internet access, etc.) where players will meet, watch TV and spend free time;
- leisure facilities (gym, swimming pool, sauna, etc.) and access to relaxation areas nearby (parks, etc.);
- drop-off point for buses and parking facilities; and
- a full laundry service including weekends with a delivery time of 24 hours at a reasonable price.



3 – Team's training centre

Each team must be provided with a training centre which is, ideally, located within a 15 minutes bus drive from the team's hotel but not longer than a 30 minutes bus drive.

The requirements for the team training centres are:

- exclusive use of the training centre for the respective team, as a general rule, from two days before the team's first match in the Tournament until the day after the team's elimination from the Tournament or the day after the final;
- a car park available for the team's bus;
- one top quality natural grass pitch of, ideally, a dimension of 105m x 68m;
- one dressing room with modern infrastructure with benches and clothes hanging facilities for at least 25 persons, 3 toilets, 4 showers, 2 washbasins with mirrors and 1 sink for cleaning boots;

- one medical treatment room with related equipment;
- training facilities in a clean, safe and protected environment which provide privacy and, if requested, can be secured in order to ensure closed training sessions;
- protective fencing behind each goal to prevent footballs from exiting the grounds of the training centre;
- if possible, a floodlighting system of an adequate intensity in order to host evening training sessions; and
- room to provide refreshment to team officials and media representatives.



4 – Referees' hotel requirements

Referees' hotel

The team of referees, along with their assistants, officials and medical and administrative staff, will stay at the referee's hotel for the entire duration of the Tournament. The referees' hotel must be either a good 3-star or 4-star hotel centrally located in order to respect the travel times as above-mentioned under "Distances".

The hotel must provide the following facilities and services:

- decent leisure facilities (gym, swimming pool, sauna, pool tables, etc.) and access to relaxation areas nearby (parks, etc.); and
- flexible food arrangements; and
- private dining room; and
- specific room for medical treatment/massage with massage table, ideally allocated in a spacious bedroom on the same floor or in the same wing as the other bedrooms and;
- a drop-off point for buses and parking facilities; and
