1.	Relevant Background Information
	The Committee may be aware that work is on going in the preparation of master plan the aim of which is to regenerate the Balysillan area in North Belfast. A copy of a previous report to Strategic policy & Resources is attached as Appendix A. Whilst work on this is continuing and no funding has been secured. Officers have been approached by elected representatives from the area to request that the Council, within the context of the master plan, undertake some preliminary work with the local community to explore options which would help regenerate the existing playing fields and bowling pavilion and bring it into wider use within the area.
	At this stage it is being proposed that a small steering group be established which involved officers from the Council, elected representatives from the area and representatives of existing community and sports groups in the area with a view to working up a series of options which could in turn inform a wider discussion within the area as part of the master planning process.
