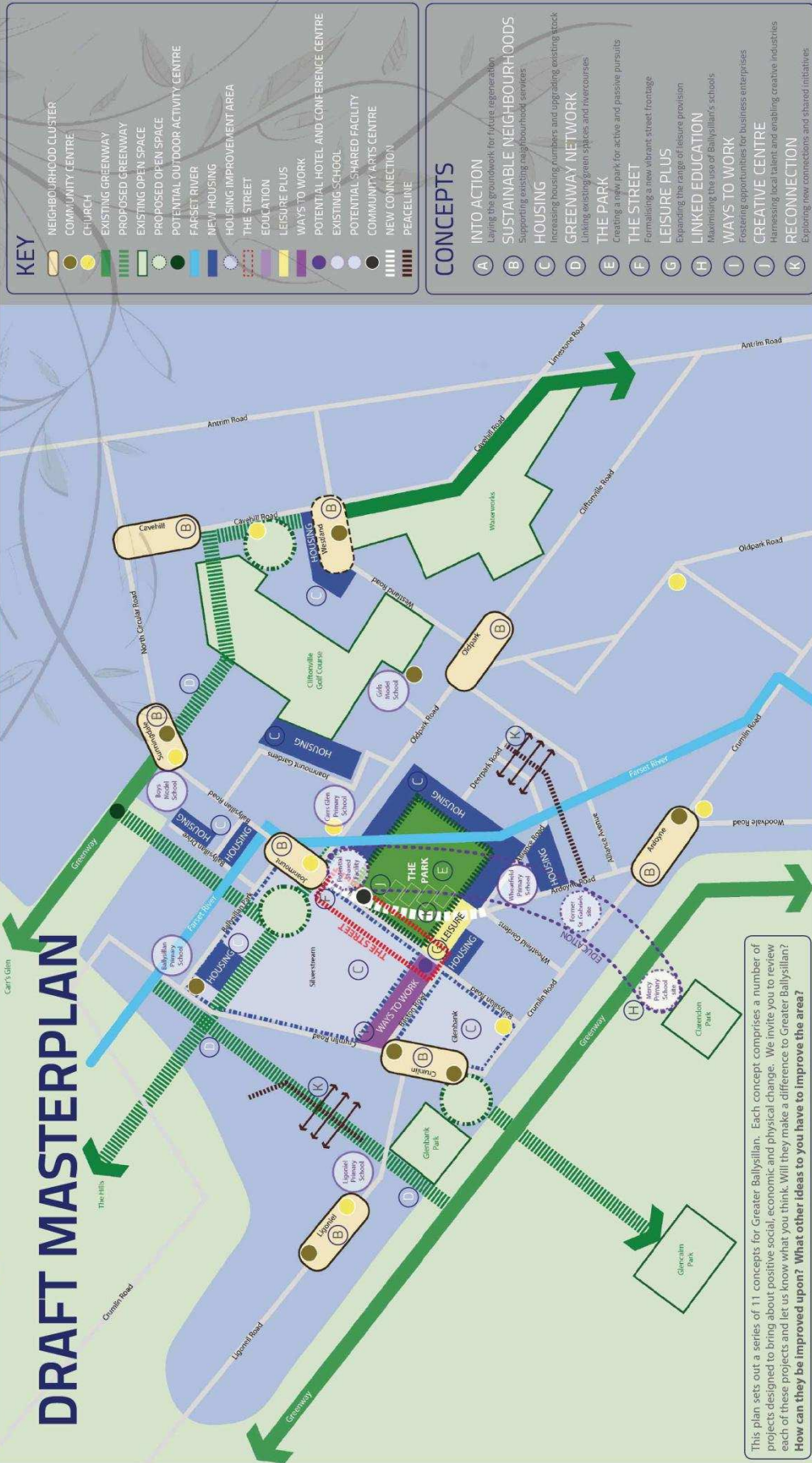

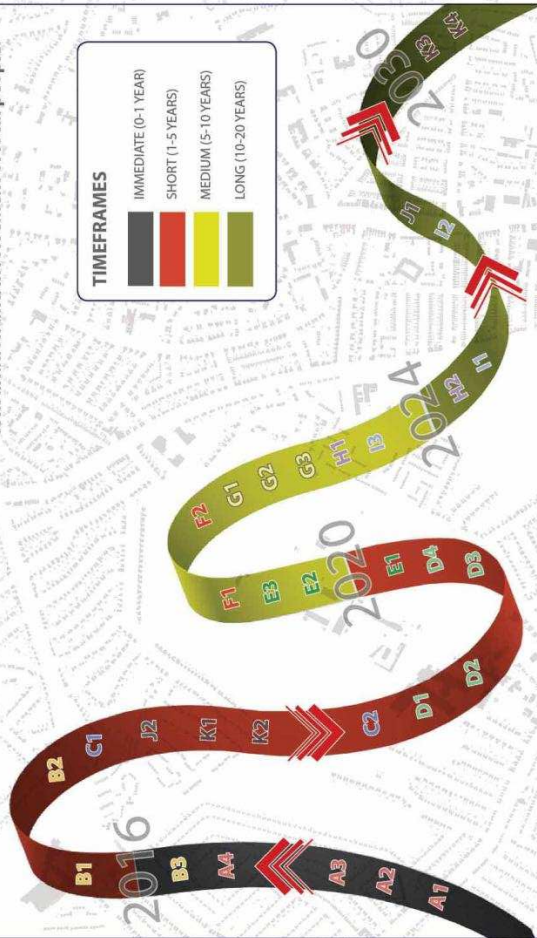

PROPOSED PHASING

The Greater Ballysillan Masterplan is designed for delivery by a host of different organisations, including central and local government agencies, private sector developers and community and charitable organisations. This will require a joint effort; working together and seeking funding from a range of different sources.

All projects will be subject to further design development and extensive consultation and involvement of local people.



The Masterplan proposals will be taken forward over a period of 10 to 20 years. This means that it will be broken down into manageable phases, with some projects advanced over the next few years and others for the longer term.
