1.	Relevant Background Information
	The Director of Parks and Leisure has received a request from the Ulster Historical Society to place a marker on the grave of Patrick Carlin, awarded a Victoria Cross and interred in an unmarked grave in Friar's Bush graveyard. Carlin was approximately 26 years old when he served as a private in The Somerset Light Infantry (Prince Albert's) during the Indian Mutiny, On 6 April 1858 at Azumgurh, India, he did the deed for which he was awarded the Victoria Cross:

	The Commander-in-Chief in India directs that the undermentioned Soldier, of the
	13th Foot, be presented, in the name of Her Most Gracious Majesty, with a
	Medal of the Victoria Cross, for valour and daring in the field, viz.: Private Patrick
	Carlin, No 3611, of the 13th Foot, for rescuing, on the 6th of April, 1858, a
	wounded Naick of the 4th Madras Rifles, in the field of battle, after killing, with
	the Naick's sword, a mutineer sepoy, who fired at him whilst bearing off his
	wounded comrade on his shoulders.

		The Ulster Covenant Society has carried out research and believes they have uncovered the location of the grave.
		Contact has been made with the Victoria Cross Trust who are involved in

repairing and marking the graves of VC winners not covered by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission and who are interested in this project.

The Trust uses a similar model to that of the War Graves Commission adopting a marker with small indents on the corners and depicting the regimental crest as well as details of the deceased.
