Relevant Background Information

The National Association of Councillors is holding a training and development seminar in London from Friday, 24th September until Sunday, 26th September.

The theme of the seminar is 'Diversity and Media' which aims to cover issues which are relevant to how Members can work with the media to promote the Council's objectives. The seminar will provide an opportunity to share best practice and to consider how best to work with the media in order to benefit local government.

The Council has been represented at NAC events in previous years and those Members who have attended have found such events to be a valuable opportunity to increase their awareness of best practice in Local Government and to discuss with other Councillors issues of mutual interest and concern.
