1 Relevant Background Information

1.1 In March 2011 the Social Investment Fund was announced by the Executive to poverty. unemployment and dereliction through community-led interventions of significant scale. The programme, led by OFMDFM, is delivered through strategic area plans. In September 2012 initial steering groups were comprising four voluntary/community established and four representatives to coordinate the development of the area plan. A council officer representative also attended with observer status. Area plans have since been developed with the ten priority projects for the areas identified. Now that the priorities are known OFMDFM wish to finalise full membership of the area steering groups by appointing four statutory and two business representatives, prior to moving into project delivery later in 2014.

2 Key Issues

- 2.1 In January 2014, Belfast City Council received correspondence from the First Minister and Deputy First Minister (attached at Appendix 1), asking for senior members of the organisation to be nominated to places one the following steering groups: Belfast North, Belfast South, Belfast East and Belfast West. It was requested these names be forwarded to the Department by the end of January.
- 2.2 The officers nominated to OFDFM were those who had previously sat on the steering groups in an observer capacity and are as follows:

Gerry Millar - Belfast North

Andrew Hassard - Belfast South John McGrillen - Belfast East

Suzanne Wylie - Belfast West

2.3 The role of the steering groups will be to oversee progress in the delivery of the area plan and review needs and issues during the first phase of SIF, which will run until March 2016.
