1.1	The Council has received a request for the use of Falls Park on Sunday 14 August 2016 to facilitate crowd dispersal at the end of a commemorative march.

<b>3.0</b>	<b>Main report</b>
3.1	The Council has received a request for the use of Falls Park on Sunday 14 August 2016 to facilitate crowd dispersal at the end of a commemorative march. The march has been organised through the appropriate authorities to mark the 35 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the hunger strikes and will start at Divis Street in lower Falls. The request is for use of the park at the end of the march for a period of approximately one and a half hours from 3.30pm to 5.00pm.
