2.0	Recommendations
2.1	The Committee is required to decide, on hearing from the applicant, whether to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Grant the application for a Provisional Amusement Permit, or ▪ Refuse the application for the grant of a Provisional Amusement Permit.
2.2	If, subsequent to hearing the applicant, you refuse the application, or decide to grant the application subject to discretionary conditions, the applicant may appeal that decision to the County Court.
