3.0	Main report					
3.1	The Council has received an approach from the Air Modelling Club currently based a					
	Alderman Tommy Patton Park requesting permission and support to host the European					
	Control Line Championships in 2019. It's anticipated that these will take place in June					
	July time, subject to confirmation.					
3.2	The proposed location for these championships will be Blanchflower Playing Fields which					
	already contains one take off and land area for model plane enthusiasts. The Chairman of the control Line Technical Committee of the British Model Flying Association has provided					
	a list of requirements. These included:					
	<ul> <li>Approval by BCC to the use of the facility no later than January 2017;</li> </ul>					
	<ul> <li>A painted area to prevent damage from paraffin for race category;</li> </ul>					
	<ul> <li>A level and short cut grassed area for Aerobatics;</li> </ul>					
	2 bitmac circles for completion					
	<ul> <li>Temporary cages to provide safety for 'pilots' when in competition;</li> </ul>					
3.3	A health and safety risk assessment has been carried out by the Club. Council Officers					
	have had several meetings with the representatives in relation to the Event Management					
	Plan. While the event is still some years off, permission is required at this time to ensure					
	that the requirements can be accommodated and necessary approvals put in place. This					
	includes, for example, discussions with the George Best Belfast City Airport.					
3.4	The Club is seeking permission to use Blanchflower Play Fields within the period June /					
	July 2019 for the purpose of hosting the European Control Line Championships.					
3.5	In addition, the Club is seeking the Council to fund the requirements as outlined above.					
	The estimated cost of the bitmac area and the provision of the cages is estimated to be					
	£30-35,000. This is a temporary fixture and the ground will be reinstated after the event.					
3.6	Officers are satisfied that the site can accommodate the requirements at present and					
	believe that this event will attract public and media interest at the time and presents an					
	opportunity to further demonstrate the ability of the city to host a range of championship					
	level events. Members will also be aware that development of the Blanchflower Playing					
	Fields is in progress, supported by the Belfast Investment Fund. Therefore any					
	rields is in progress, supported by the beliast investment rund. Therefore any					

	development of the site will be assessed in terms of its fit with the wider development
	project.
3.7	The Club will be seeking funding support beyond meeting the technical requirements.
	Officers have directed the club to existing event based funding programmes such as the small grants scheme.
3.8	Officers have considered an alternative location at Alderman Tommy Patton Park; the cost
	of the works would be reduced by approximately £5,000; however the alternative is not
	considered a suitable venue for the event owing to its size which could not accommodate
	the range of events proposed and the time of year.
3.9	Financial & Resource Implications
	The estimated cost of meeting the requirements to host the event is £30-35,000. Subject
	to Committee agreeing to fund the event from existing Departmental Budgets.
