1.1	Following your meeting on 17th August, a letter was sent to the Minister for Communities, Mr. Paul Givan MLA, requesting an update on the progress of the review of Entertainments Licensing and when his Department would be in a position to commence a public consultation on more detailed proposals to amend the legislation.
