	<u>Key Issues</u>

The application particulars are in order and the Royal Mail has no objections to the proposed names. The proposed new names are not contained in the Council's Streets Register and do not duplicate existing approved street names in the City.

3.4 The contractor has proposed Emersons for the street names because the Emerson family had a large mill in the area which was powered by the Ligoniel river which connects Emerson's Mill with the site.

3.5 The contractor has advised that the slopes of Wolfhill were the focus of the linen industry in the 19th century with a number of important works such as the Mountain spinning mill and Emerson's spinning mill which were located along the Ligoniel and Crumlin roads.
