- The contractor has proposed Emersons for the street names because the Emerson family had a large mill in the area which was powered by the Ligoniel river which connects Emerson's Mill with the site.
- 3.5 The contractor has advised that the slopes of Wolfhill were the focus of the linen industry in the 19th century with a number of important works such as the Mountain spinning mill and Emerson's spinning mill which were located along the Ligoniel and Crumlin roads.
