3.4	Dependencies
0.4	Most of this work is affected by relationships and timeframe. The balance of maintaining a
	mutual consensus and demonstrate ownership whilst there may be competing interests or
	needs has been noted throughout and will continue to be an area which the future
	governance will continue to require support with. This needs managed aligned to normal
	council process yet be timely to ensure any potential funding or income streams can be
	realised. An internal working group is on hand to try to pool Council support as progress
	continues and proposals in the plan are scoped to support this too.
