	Approximately 93	% of these applications have been appro-	ved. The	Counci	l's Pl	anning	
	Committee has de	termined close to 430 planning applications.	This is ap	proxim	ately	13% of	
	all applications, w	ith a delegation rate of 87%.					

3.2	Major developments				
	Since transfer, the Council has determined approximately 80 applications for Major				
	developments. The approval rate for 2016/17 was 97%. This demonstrates the Planning				
	Service's strong commitment to engaging with its customers, working through issues, and				
	finding solutions so that significant development projects can be progressed. All of these				
	Major applications were determined by the Planning Committee as required by statute.				
3.3	These permissions have included many Major city centre schemes, and include:				
	17 permissions for hotels (or circa 1,500 beds)				
	21 permissions for offices (circa 150,000 sq. m. floor space)				
	12 permissions for Purpose Built Student Accommodation (circa 5,800 beds)				
3.4	The total construction value of these developments is estimated at around £400 million,				
	broken down as follows				
	Hotels – £70 million				
	Offices – £165 million				
	Purpose Built Student Accommodation – £175 million				
	Total – £410 million				
3.5	A map showing the location of these Major permissions is provided at <b>Appendix 1</b> .				
3.6	The above information gives the Committee a picture of the contribution that the Plannii				
	Service is making to development across the city, including investment in the city centre.
