1.0	Purpose of Report or Summary of main Issues
1.1	To consider a notice of motion in relation to a 'Stained Glass Window – 321 Explosives Ordnance Disposal Company which, in accordance with standing orders, was referred to the Committee by the Council at its meeting on 2 nd May.

Main report
Key Issues
At the meeting of the Council on 2 nd May, the following notice of motion, which was proposed by Councillor Graham and seconded by Councillor Johnston, was, in accordance with Standing Order 13(f), referred to the Committee for consideration:
"This Council acknowledges the vital role which 321 Explosives Ordnance Disposal Company, Royal Army Ordnance Corps, has provided to our City and its citizens over a number of decades. Their sacrifice and dedication has saved many lives and helped preserve our city from those who would physically destroy it. The Council agrees to commission a stained glass window to acknowledge their dedication and service and install this in an appropriate location in the City Hall."
The Committee will recall that, at its meeting on 21 st April, it considered a report (copy attached at appendix 1) on a proposal for a stained glass window to recognise the contribution of the LGBT community. The report also provided details of other proposals for stained glass windows which have been considered during the previous four years.
The Committee agreed to refer that proposal, in the first instance, to the Party Leaders.
