3.2 By way of background, Changing Places are facilities whereby people with profound and multiple disabilities can avail of toilet and personal hygiene amenities, designed specifically for their needs. Providing these facilities offers those with such conditions, and their carers, the same potential to participate in community activity and active citizenship which many of us take for granted.

## **Changing Places - Current Provision**

- 3.3 The Council's Public Convenience Provision presented to Members on 6 February 2013 outlined the role which Changing Places facilities could play in supporting city development. At the time of this report, there were three Changing Places in the city and presently there are six located at the following venues:
  - Girdwood Community Hub (North Belfast)
  - George Best Belfast City Airport (East Belfast)
  - Mencap Centre (Newtownbreda South Belfast)
  - Northern Ireland Assembly (East Belfast)
  - Divis & Black Mountain (West Belfast)
  - Olympia Leisure Centre (South Belfast)

- 3.5 Girdwood Community Hub and Olympia Leisure Centre are two relatively recent additions to the list and have been installed as a result of the Council's lead role in delivering these projects.

## Changing Places - Future Provision

- 3.6 As part of the redevelopment of the Leisure Centre estate there are proposals to install two further Changing Places at the following locations:
  - Robinson Centre (East Belfast due 2019)
  - Andersonstown LC (West Belfast due 2019).
- 3.7 Members will be aware that the City Hall is in the process of being upgraded and, as part of this development, there is a proposal to construct additional toilets including a Changing Places facility within the building. This currently sits at Stage 2 *uncommitted project* of the Council's Capital Projects process.

3.8	Additionally, there is a proposal for a Changing Places facility in a new pavilion which is		
	being proposed at Cathedral Gardens. This new pavilion is an element of Belfast Streets		
	Ahead public realm project and is expected to be delivered by the Department for		
	Communities. It too is Stage 2 of the Council's Capital Programme. Members are asked to		
	note that, as Stage 2 projects, there has been no committed investment decision in respect		
	of these projects.		
3.9	The Council will continue to engage with stakeholders delivering major city centre		
	development projects in order to promote the installation of Changing Places facilities as		
	appropriate.
