



Current initiatives

- Business Growth Programme: support programme tailored to the needs of participants to help them grow.
- Innovation Factory business growth and innovation services: delivered by Innovation Factory operator.
- Conference and partner sponsorship.
- Creative and Digital Industries: support for the CDI sector through a range of activities:
 - **Creative Accelerator Programme:** growth support via knowledge transfer, networking, mentoring and access to new international business opportunities.
 - Cartoon Business: A two and half-day conference, attracting over 250 European animation professionals.
 - Output Belfast: exploit opportunities at events including SXSW 2018, MIDEM and The Great Escape and support for private sector events including Digital DNA, BelTech, TechXplore and Audio Visual Arts Conference.
- Retail: a range of support for local retail business development through:
 - Funding area-based retail trade associations.
 - **Retail and Tourism Sector Programme:** support to become more sustainable and competitive.
- Access Mobility: support to individuals with disabilities or mobility impairments to access the city centre.

New for 2017/18

Exports and international trade:

- Membership and collaboration with NI Chamber of Commerce, including involvement in their member events and missions.
- consider opportunities to better exploit World Trade Centre membership.
- providing businesses opportunities to explore business opportunities through Belfast's Sister Cities networks.

Growth sector support:

- Work with the Centre for Secure Information Technology (CSIT) to deliver on cyber security strategy for NI.
- work with Invest NI and other partners on action plans for Financial Technology (Fin Tech), Legal Services, Life and Health Sciences and Creative Industries.
- New business accelerator models: explore new models
 which provide benefits such as office space, intensive
 training, world-class mentoring and access to in-kind
 benefits for businesses with high growth potential.
- Innovation Factory: continue to work closely with the Innovation Factory operator to ensure that we remain on track to meet our occupancy and income targets.
