3.1	The Strategic Cemeteries and Crematorium Working Group is a Working Group of the

	the political parties.

	preferred option but that there are variations within this that need further exploration.

3.4	The Working Group noted the update provided and that officers would hold further

	provided to the Members.

3.5	Members were updated on the findings of the survey of crematorium users and that the

	responses had been positive. There were some comments relating to the inadequacy of
	the facilities to deal with the number of cremations and these will be fed into the process
	around the development of future facilities. Members noted the information provided and
	agreed in principle to the change in frequency of the survey to annual and the associated
	change to nomination process for charitable donations regarding recycled metals.

3.6	Members noted the update that was provided on the meeting with memorial
	sculptors/stones masons that was held on 23 <sup>rd</sup> May 2017 and that a future meeting would
	take place in the autumn.

	undertaken to install a permanent memorial to mark Plot Z1 in the City Cemetery and that
