As you see from the table, it would appear that one council i.e. Lisburn and Castlereagh City Council has marginally exceeded its annual allowance. Consequently, the arc21 NILAS Transfer Protocol, previously agreed by the arc21 Joint Committee and each Council, will again be triggered. This will be the fifth time the arc21 Transfer Protocol has been utilised in the thirteen years of NILAS existence.

Course of Action

As per the protocol, the relative position in respect to the proportion of populations assigned to the allocation of transfers is as set out in Table 2 below.

Applying the proportionate percentage of population and assigning this to the transfer of relevant allowances to Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council, the indicative position is set out in Table 3 below.
