Proposed Name	Location	Applicant
Oldpark Grange	Off Oldpark Road, BT14	Clanmil Housing Association

The housing association has proposed Oldpark Grange as the new street name as it is located off Oldpark Road and is in keeping with the existing names in the area. Bells Hill and Bells Lane have been proposed as a second and third choice as the development is being built on the site of a former blinds factory called the Charles Bell Blind Factory which previously provided employment to local residents.
