1.1	A request has been made by East Belfast Community Development Agency (EBCDA) for

3.0	Main report
	Overview
3.1	The SIF funded CCLP project aims to build the core capacity of organisations and individuals within those organisations by developing leadership, community relations and community development skills, knowledge and abilities.
3.2	The CCLP is targeting 13 Super Output Areas in east Belfast that fall within the top 20% of the most deprived in Northern Ireland.
3.3	The programme will be delivered by a consortium including; Northern Ireland Council for Voluntary Action (NICVA), Tides Training, Interaction Institute for Social Change (IISC) and Youth Action NI.
3.4	The programme will use a wide range of techniques and processes including: one to one training, action learning, formal training, round table workshops and mentoring.
3.5	EBCDA has overall management responsibility for the delivery of the project. They are now inviting a wide range of organisations to be members of a Project Board and these include Belfast City Council, Belfast Regeneration Directorate (DfC), Education Authority Youth Service, The Executive Office, Strategic Investment Board and NICVA. EBCDA will Chair the Board.
3.6	It is anticipated that the board would initially meet on a monthly basis with a reduction in frequency as the project becomes established. The project has received initial funding for two-years.
3.7	Given the link to the Community Development Capacity/ Training Programme delivered by Community Services, officers propose the Community Resource Unit Manager would represent BCC.
