Purpose

To build the core capacity of organisations and individuals within those organisations, by developing their leadership, community relations and community development skills, knowledge and ability.

How

Through one to one training, action learning, formal training, roundtable workshops and mentoring.

- Leadership for Building Active Communities
- Leadership for Collaboration
- Leadership in Diverse Communities
- Leading Networks

Management and Delivery

EBCDA will be managing the overall process of ensuring the delivery of the CC&LP. The programme delivery will be carried out by a consortium of NICVA, Tides Training, Interaction Institute and YouthAction NI. Each member of the Consortium will have the following responsibility:

- NICVA - Lead Partner and delivery of Governance, Policy, Leadership, Mentoring and Bespoke Programme
- Interaction Institute – Facilitative Leadership
- Tides – Community Relations and Diversity
- YouthAction NI – Youth Programme
