3.3	Deputations will normally only be admitted to the Council if the Chief Executive shall have			
	received seven days previous written notice of the intended deputation and its purpose.			
	Deputations shall not comprise of more than 3 persons and shall be restricted to making			
	not more than two short speeches of not more than 10 minutes total duration. If the matter upon which the Deputation wishes to address the Council falls within the remit of a			
	Committee, the Lord Mayor may direct that the Deputation shall be heard at that			
	Committee rather than at the Council meeting."
