3.1	The Committee may recall that the Greater Clarendon (Sailortown) Masterplan was published					
	by the Department for Communities (DfC) in December, 2016, following a consultation exercise to which the Council submitted a corporate response.

3.2	The plan committed the Department to the preparation of a Delivery Framework and establishing a forum of key stakeholders which would;					
	Support the development of the Delivery Framework;					
	<ul> <li>Support the development of the Delivery Framework;</li> <li>Support and advise in terms of the delivery and monitoring of the Framework; and</li> </ul>					
	<ul> <li>Provide a key communication channel with other key stakeholders.</li> </ul>					
3.3	The forum membership will be drawn from across the private, community and business sectors					
	and statutory agencies. The Draft Terms of Reference (attached at appendix 1) provides further detail.					
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3.4	The first meeting of the forum is scheduled to be held on 16th November. It is expected that					
	the Forum will meet at least on one further occasion in December/January to finalise the					
	Delivery Framework. Thereafter, the Forum will meet to support and advise in terms of the					
	delivery and monitoring of the Framework as well as continue to provide a key communication					
	channel with stakeholders.					
3.5	The Department for Communities has issued an invitation for all Members of both the Castle					
	and Oldpark District Electoral Areas to be appointed to the Forum.					
3.6	It should be pointed out that the appointments are not based on proportionality but					
0.0	geographically based. Therefore, it would be appropriate for the Committee to accept the					
	invitation.
