1.1	The purpose of this report is to report to committee on the key issues discussed at the Shared City Partnership meeting held on 9 th October 2017.
2.0	Recommendations
2.1	That the Strategic Policy and Resources Committee approve the minutes and the recommendations from the Shared City Partnership Meeting held on 9 th October 2017. <ul style="list-style-type: none">To note the allocation of £102,594 to support 24 organisations to deliver good relations projects through the Good Relations Grant Aid Tranche 1 17/18 which had been approved for funding under the delegated authority of the Director of City and Neighbourhood Services.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To agree that should underspend in excess of £20,000 be identified through the Good Relations Action Plan, it would be redirected to support six additional projects through the Tranche 2 Good Relations Small Grants Programme. • The adoption of Option 3, as an interim arrangement for 2018/19, until the results of the review of City festivals and events was available; and • Due to the significance of International Day of Peace, it be prioritised within the context of the review.
3.0	Main report
	<u>Key Issues</u>
3.1	The Shared City Partnership (formerly known as the Good Relations Partnership) is a Working Group of the Strategic Policy and Resources Committee which consists of Elected members and representatives from various sectors across the city. The minutes from the Partnership are brought before the Committee for approval on a monthly basis.
3.2	The key issues on the agenda at the October meeting were: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presentation on Decade of Centenaries • Update on Peace IV • Good Relations Grant Aid 2017/18- Tranche 1 • International day of Peace
3.3	More details regarding the above issues and recommendations are included in the minutes of the meeting
	<u>Financial & Resource Implications</u>
3.4	The financial implications of all recommendations in relation to grant aid are contained within existing budgets. In relation to International Day of Peace, an amount of 10k could be allocated from the GR Action Plan budget 18/19, however, further resources would need to be sought for full implementation.

3.5	The recommendations of the Partnership promote the work of the Council in promoting good relations and will enhance equality and good relations impacts.
