3.0 Main report

3.1 Young at Art has successfully delivered events since 1998. This children's festival will mark the 20th children's festival delivered. The event is children orientated and will include activities such as a Luminarium (Architects of Air). Architects of Air build 'luminaria' – monumental inflatable structures designed to generate a sense of wonder at the beauty of light and colour. Each Luminarium is a dazzling maze of winding paths and soaring domes. The domes are large chambers rising up to 10 metres high that provide the focal points which create the beauty of light and colour. Appendix 2 sets out in full the detail of the event and its delivery.

From, Hong Kong to Honolulu, Taipei to Tel Aviv, Sydney to Singapore, the monumental walk-in sculptures of Architects of Air have enchanted audiences around the world. Since

1992, over 3 million visitors in 41 countries across 5 continents have immersed themselves in the spectacular, luminous world of Architects of Air which will come to Belfast from its current position in Germany. To assist with the cost of provision, there will be a charge of £3 per person. Time slots will control the numbers. The Luminarium has the capacity to hold

80 people at any one time.

In addition there will also be theatre performances which will cost £10 per person and will focus on children aged 7+ years. This is a standard ticket price for a children's festival ticket. These are the only chargeable activities.

There will be a huge range of free activities throughout Botanic Gardens and the Ulster museum, including; sow and grow workshops, arts and crafts, treasure trails, drumming workshops, walk about performers, magicians, dance and learning zones.
