3.1	Key Issues Correspondence has been received from ABF The Soldier's Charity (NI) concerning an event entitled The 'Ulster at War' Concert to be held in the Belfast Waterfront on Saturday, 24 th March, 2018 (see attached appendix).
3.1.2	The Charity is seeking to recreate 1940s Ulster by means of music, comedy and fascinating stories of local heroism from every corner of the Province. The event will be hosted by 'Fermanagh Funny Man' Gary Wilson.
