Executive Summary:

Listed Building Consent is sought for the erection of accessible ramps, partial replacement of steps, new railings to Korean War Memorial and associated works at the Cenotaph and Garden of Remembrance.


The main issue to be considered is the effect of the proposal upon the character and appearance of the Grade A Listed Building.

surrounding the garden.

The key issue in the assessment of this Listed Building Consent application is consideration of any potential impact on the Grade A listed building.

The proposed works include the removal of two handrails and replacement with the erection of accessible ramps measuring approximately 11m by 6m, partial replacement of steps, new railings to Korean War Memorial and associated works.

Policy BH 8 of PPS 6 states that consent will be granted for proposals for the extension or alteration of a listed building where the essential character of the building and its setting are retained and its features of special interest remain unimpaired and the architectural details match or are in keeping with the building.

In accordance with Policy BH 11 of PPS 6, proposals will normally only be considered appropriate where the detailed design respects the listed building in terms of scale, height, massing and alignment; the works proposed make use of traditional or sympathetic building materials and techniques which respect those found on the building; and the nature of the use proposed respects the character of the setting of the building.

Amendments were received following Historic Environment Division response dated 12th December 2017. Historic Environment Division have considered the amended proposal and have stated that it satisfies the SPPS paragraphs 6.13: Change of use, Extension or Alteration of a Listed Building and paragraph 6.12: Development proposals impacting on the Setting of Listed Buildings and Policies BH 8 and BH 11 of PPS 6.

The proposed development is not considered inappropriate within the setting of the Listed Building. The proposal is not considered to negatively affect the visual harmony of the building. The proposed ramps allow for wheelchair access to the garden of remembrance which was not previously easily accessible for wheelchair users. The proposal is considered acceptable as it does not affect the character of the listed building and its surrounding area.
