| 1.1 | The purpose of this paper is to advise Members of a request to support the siting of a bronzed <br> sculpture entitled "Homeless Jesus" on a bench outside City Hall to raise awareness of the <br> issue of homelessness within Belfast. |

| 3.1 | Officers have recently been contacted in relation to a request for support to site the bronzed <br> sculpture entitled "Homeless Jesus" on a bench outside City Hall to raise awareness of <br> homelessness within the City. One such sculpture currently exists outside Centenary House <br> on Victoria Street which is run by the Salvation Army. |
| 3.2 | The sculpture, which was designed by Timothy Schmalz, depicts Jesus as a homeless man <br> sleeping on a bench and can be identified as Jesus by the marks on the feet. It has been in <br> existence worldwide since 2013 and has been placed in areas within Madrid, Singapore, <br> Dublin, and Glasgow. <br> 3.3Key Issues <br> There are currently plans for a procession to take place from Centenary House to the Morning <br> Star Hostel on the Falls Road which is run by the Legion of Mary to install a further statue. A <br> date for this event has yet to be organised. |
| 3.4 | Council's support is being sought for a procession from the Morning Star Hostel to the City <br> Hall during the week of 10 th-18 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ November which has been designated as an annual event <br> to highlight homelessness with a culmination of the sculpture being placed on a bench <br> outside City Hall. The procession would involve representatives from the four main churches <br> as well as the Salvation Army. <br> 3.5Financial \& Resource Implications <br> Officers have been advised that costs regarding the sculpture are already covered.
