	<p data-bbox="272 206 421 237"><u>Key Issues</u></p> <p data-bbox="165 255 1474 338">3.1 The power for the Council to name streets is contained in Article 11 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (NI) Order 1995.</p> <p data-bbox="165 407 1474 640">3.2 Members are asked to consider the following applications for naming new streets and the realignment of abandoned streets in the City. The application particulars are in order and the Royal Mail has no objections to the proposed names. 3.5	The second and third choice that have been proposed as alternatives to Stirling Green are Stirling Grove and Glensharragh Green.
3.6	All names were proposed by schoolchildren from Lisnasharragh Primary School in a street naming competition.
3.7	Hagan Homes have advised that the two original streets; Kitchener Street and Broadway Parade are streets that were previously abandoned and the streets are now being redeveloped with the new roads being created adjacent to where the original roads were located. The developer has indicated that he wishes to retain the original street names for the realigned roads.
