	they have committed to developing a strategy for aquatics for the period 2018 – 2030.		
	Following pre-consultation last summer with key stakeholders including schools, swimming		
	clubs and other water based sport clubs who use our facilities the partners have drafted a		
	strategy which is attached as appendix 1. Throughout the development process of the		
	draft strategy it has been agreed at key stages by the Active Belfast Board and reported		
	through this Committee.		
	Next steps		
3.2	The next stage in the process is to undertake a public consultation on the draft strategy.		
	Subject to Council approval it is proposed that the public consultation would take place		
	from Monday 23 rd July to Friday 12 th October. The public consultation would include the		
	use of the Council's online platform Citizen Space and public information sessions. The		
	consultation would be publicised through the usual Council communication channels and		
	the information sessions will be held towards the end of the consultation period (after the		
	main holiday period) to ensure maximum participation.		
3.3	It is anticipated that the findings from the pubic consultations and the final strategy with any		
	proposed amendments as a result of the consultation will be brought to the November		
	meeting of this committee for consideration and final approval.
