	polling day will be on Thursday, 2 <sup>nd</sup> May, the Annual meeting must be held no later than	
	23 <sup>rd</sup> May.

3.2	There is a significant amount of work which will be required to be undertaken immediately	
0.2	after the election to sort out the governance arrangements, including the nominations for	
	Positions of Responsibility, the appointment of Committees etc. and it is anticipated that	
	this work will continue up until 15 <sup>th</sup> or 16 <sup>th</sup> May. It is suggested, therefore, that the Annual	
	meeting is held on Tuesday 21 <sup>st</sup> May at 6.00pm.	
3.3	It is accepted that all political parties will be extremely busy with canvassing in the lead up	
	to polling day, and particularly during the month of April. It will be necessary to continue	
	with the Standing Committees in that month and the Committee has already agreed that	
	the May Council meeting will be brought forward to Monday, 29th April.
