	growers in addition to attracting a significant number of visitors. The rose trials are ju-		
	by a panel of Local and International Judges which is then followed by a civic luncheon and		
	drinks reception in City Hall.		
3.2	The Lord Mayor's Office has hosted this function for over four decades and it has prove		
	be beneficial in promoting Belfast to an international audience. International Judges have		
	attended from the USA, Europe, New Zealand, Australia, Great Britain and the Republic of		
	Ireland. The function is attended by approximately 150 guests which includes Elected		
	Members, Judges, The Rose Society of Northern Ireland, rose breeders, awards' sponsors		
	and relevant Council Staff.		
3.3	It is proposed that this function will continue to be held annually in July in City Hall and
