General Fayre Criteria:

- We give priority to handmade, artisan products from independent traders and to those using locally sourced produce and products, local recipes, materials and crafts.
- 2. We aim for 70% of traders to be from the East/ Wider Belfast Area. The remining 30% can be made up from other parts of NI/ Ireland. Preference shall be given to traders from East Belfast where other criteria are met.
- 3. We will give preference to traders who are environmentally conscious and use minimal plastic packaging.
- 4. Stalls and products must be of high quality and provide good value for money.

Living the Green Way Fayre Criteria:

- 1. Priority will be given to traders who promote zero waste, minimal plastic packaging, upcycling, environmental awareness and sustainability.
- 2. Preference will be given to handmade, artisan products from independent traders and to those using locally sourced produce and products, and to those using local recipes, materials and crafts.
- 3. Stalls and products must be of high quality and provide good value for money.
- 4. Products should be ethically made and use organic materials where possible.
- 5. Preference will be given to traders from East Belfast where possible and only if other criteria are met.

All products on sale must be reasonably priced and well presented.

Costs

All stalls cost £10.
Use of Electricity costs £10.
Use of a Gazebo costs £5.

Costs from the Fayre will contribute towards the animation of the event.

Any claims in relation to the standards of your products, e.g. 'Organic' must be documented and documentation must be displayed.
